RESOLUTION NO 1: RESOLVED to appropriate the sum of \$41,000 to the Public Works Department to meet the cost of a new truck for the Public Works Supervisor, said appropriation to be met by a transfer from the Capital and Non-Recurring Reserve Fund.

Motion made by Trish Viola and seconded by Liz Lavia. The item was explained by First Selectman, Clay Cope, and after discussion, the motion CARRIED by a show of cards.

RESOLUTION NO 2: RESOLVED to appropriate the sum of \$75,000 for a security system at the Sherman School, said appropriation to be met by a transfer from the Capital and Non-Recurring Reserve Fund. It is anticipated that a portion of such appropriation will be reimbursed through a grant from the Connecticut Local Capital Improvement Program.

Motion made by Frank Spaziani and properly seconded. The item was explained by First Selectman Cope and Robert Gamper, Chairman of the Board of Education, together with members of the board and school principal and vice-principal. After discussion, the motion CARRIED by a show of cards.
