RESOLUTION NO. 1: RESOLVED to revise the ordinance entitled, "Tax Relief for the Elderly and Totally Disabled Persons" dated August 8, 2008 as to Section F, to increase the credit and income limits." Motion made by Arthur von Plachecki, seconded by George Linkletter, and after explanation by Arthur vonPlachecki and discussion, CARRIED by a show of cards.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE ENTITLED "TAX RELIEF FOR THE ELDERLY AND TOTALLY DISABLED PERSONS"

RESOLVED that the Town revise the ordinance entitled, "Tax Relief for the Elderly and Totally Disabled Persons", dated August 8, 2008 as to Section F, to increase the credit and income limits.

F. The otherwise qualifying applicant's income shall meet the following criteria in order to be eligible for relief in the form of an annual tax credit as described in this section:
The income of a couple not to exceed \$42,900 from whatever source derived, including, without limitation, social security payments, for a credit of \$1,050 per taxable year.
The income of a couple not to exceed \$20,000 from whatever source derived, including, without limitation, social security payments, for a credit of \$1,800 per taxable year.
The income of a single not to exceed \$35,200 from whatever source derived, including, without limitation, social security payments, for a credit of \$800 per taxable year.
The income of a single not to exceed \$17,500 from whatever source derived, including without limitation, social security payments, for a credit of \$1,300 per taxable year.
This revision to take effect with the 2015 Grant List, with an application date commencing February 1, 2016.

RESOLUTION NO. 2: RESOLVED to approve a request from the Sherman Vol. Fire Dept. for a re-appropriation of funds intended to support the operations of the SVFD not to exceed \$7,500. These funds, originally approved for the acquisition of blood gas monitors, are now to be used to acquire Automated External Defibrillators. Motion made by Arthur vonPlachecki and seconded by George Linkletter. After explanation by First Selectman Clay Cope and discussion the motion CARRIED by a show of cards.

RESOLUTION NO. 3: RESOLVED to approve an expenditure not to exceed \$7,500 from the Happy Acres Restricted Fund for a trenching and plumbing project for Happy Acres Farm. Motion made by Arthur von Plachecki, seconded by George Linkletter and after explanation by First Selectman Cope and discussion the motion CARRIED by a show of cards.
